Notice is hereby given of the intention to submit an application, and the public participation, process in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998), as amended ("NEMA"), Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations 2014. The proposed development of a 25m high telecommunication mast on Erf 588, NababEEP, Nama Khoi Local Municipality, Northern Cape, and includes activities listed in terms of the NEMA EIA Regulations, 2014.

EnviroAfrica cc has been appointed by Eagle Towers SA (Pty) Ltd, to undertake the NEMA EIA Application for Environmental Authorisation process.

The proposed development is to clear an area of 7m X 8m (56m²) to erect a 25m high Monopole mast with antennas situated on the top of the proposed structure. The proposed telecommunication mast and base station will be situated on a site zoned for Open Space Zone I and located is within the urban area of NababEEP Central. The telecommunication mast, including associated infrastructure, is proposed on Erf 588 NababEEP, Northern Cape. The site co-ordinates are **29°35'37.78" S, 17°46'55.64" E**.
