Project Description & Location:
 A telecommunications mast, including associated infrastructure, is proposed on Erf 90, Bond Street, De Hoop, Oudtshoorn, Western Cape. The proposed development is to clear an area of 64m² to erect a 35m high monopole mast with antennas situated on the top of the proposed structure. No new roads will be constructed as an existing access road will be utilised to gain access to the proposed site. Access to the site will be gained via Bond Street. The proposed site is located outside the urban area and is zoned Single Residential and the site co-ordinates are 33° 36' 27.65" S, 22° 2' 38.91" E.
