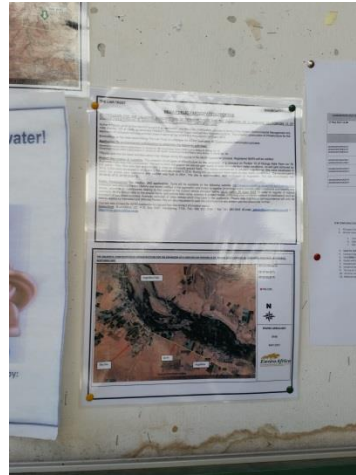

Notice is hereby given of the intention to submit an application, and the public participation, process in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998), as amended ("NEMA"), Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations 2014. The unlawful construction of infrastructure for the expansion of vineyards includes activities listed in terms of the NEMA EIA Regulations 2010 and 2014.

EnviroAfrica cc has been appointed by The Lair Trust, to undertake the NEMA Application for Environmental Authorisation process.

Project Description & Location: The unlawful construction of infrastructure for the expansion of a vineyard on Portion 13 of Orange Falls Farm no 16, Augrabies Falls Way has commenced. The soil in which the grapes are planted gets ripped in order to create favourable conditions, no soil gets removed by this action. The 10ha area that is developed is done on previously grazed fields. The activity commenced in different time frames, 5ha were developed in 2010; 2.5ha were developed in 2012 and 2.5ha were developed in 2016. During this development there were no new roads constructed. The warehouse in which the grapes gets processed and packed was built in 2001. The site is approximately 6km north-west of Augrabies. The site co-ordinates are 28°39'30.16"S, 20°20'28.81"E.
