Mr. Shubane and Mr. Alberts informed all present that the Basic Assessments has to be completed in full again. However, the specialist studies do not need a full report again if there are no changes. Specialist can just confirm (verify the findings of the original report) or update the previous report. Mr. Alberts emphasized that the specialist must go visit the site again. Specialist not allowed to simply write a confirmation. The specialist studies will include but not limited to agriculture, visuals, bio diversity, heritage, and socio economics.

For public participation the specialist report as well as the application must be submitted using the 2014 format. Any specialist studies conducted in house must be reviewed externally.

It is important to make sure of all the regulations. If anything unclear EnviroAfrica can contact Mr. Shubane and get clarity.

Responses to comments pertaining to public participation must be addressed accordingly and adequately. "Noted" is not a response. There must also be a comment and response report. The comments and where they were addressed in the report must be clear.

The report must include a clarification if there are no alternatives for technology used or alternative sites.

Mr. Alberts advised that applications should be in before 15 December. DEA will be closed 15 December to 5 January 2017. No public participation can take place during this time period

If all specialist studies are completed – one round of public participation will be sufficient. DEA will only provide comment on the Basic Assessment Report once an Application Form has been submitted.

Need and desirability must be addressed in the Basic Assessment Report. Just an “umbrella” response that the project is required to provide additional energy to Eskom is not the only “need”. The Need and Desirability must therefore be addressed in more detail.

When submitting the entire report, an original plus one hard copy and 2 CD’s must be submitted. The application must be included on the CD’s.

Cumulative impacts must be addressed. The impacts of any other renewable projects within a 30km radius of the site must be evaluated. Specialists must also take this into consideration. The DEA website can be accessed for a database of renewable projects (new builds). Mr. Shubane to email the link to the database to EnviroAfrica.

Plan of Study

These are the following steps to be conducted for the NEMA Application in terms of the NEMA EIA Regulations 2014 as discussed in the meeting:

- Specialists to conduct site visit and to verify their original findings and/or to update their specialist reports
- EAP to update the Basic Assessment Report (BAR) on the 2014 BAR template.
- EAP to compile 2014 NEMA Application Form and to submit to DEA (90 day legislated timeframe begins)
- EAP to conduct the public participation in terms of the 2014 Regulations. This will include newspaper advertisement, site posters, notification letters to neighbouring land owners and occupiers etc and to other potential I&APs as per the NEMA regulations, as well as to all registered I&APs, notifying them of the NEMA Application, and the availability of the BAR for viewing and comment for a 30 day comment period. The BAR will also be distributed to all relevant State Departments and Organs of State , including DEA, for comment.
- After the 30 day comment period, a Comments and Response report will be compiled. The C&R report will be included in the Final BAR to be submitted to DEA (within the 90 day legislated timeframe) for a decision.
- If required by, and approved by DEA, the 90 day legislated timeframe will be increased by 50 days, if the BAR is substantially amended or substantial additional information is included in the BAR, as a result of comments received on the BAR during the public participation period. 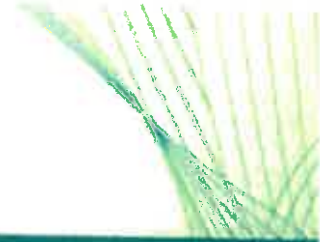

resources were found within the alternative area. The author argued that the proposed area for development does not contain landforms or terrains where archaeological remains may be expected to be found and the proposed area for development has been degraded by Eskom infrastructure. Recommendations include the following:

- An AIA of the proposed site (Erf 753) for the solar energy farm is not required and no further archaeological mitigation is required; and
- Should any unmarked human burials/remains or ostrich eggshell water flask caches be uncovered, or exposed during construction activities, these must immediately be reported to the archaeologist or SAHRA. Burials, etc must not be removed or disturbed until inspected by the archaeologist.

Almond, J. E. 2012. Recommended Exemption from further Palaeontological Studies & Mitigation: Proposed Danielskuil Roma Energy Solar Plant, Kgatelopele Local Municipality, Northern Cape.

The propose development is underlain by the Campbell Rand Subgroup and in particular the Koegelbeen Formation. The Koegelbeen Formation contains stromatolites, microbial laminates and oolitic facies. The Precambrian sedimentary rocks are overlain by superficial deposits of aeolian sands and alluvium and are largely unfossiliferous. It was recommended that the project be exempted from further specialist palaeontological studies. Should any substantial fossil remains (e.g. vertebrate bones and teeth, shells, petrified wood) be encountered during excavation, however, these should be reported to SAHRA for possible mitigation by a professional palaeontologist.

Final Comment

SAHRA Archaeology, Palaeontology and Meteorites (APM) Unit accepts heritage specialist reports and promotes the recommendations therein. The recommendations of the heritage specialists and the following conditions must be included in the Final BAR and the Environmental Management Programme (EMPr):

- A Walk-down of the final layout of the solar plant must be conducted prior to the construction phase. A report detailing the results of the walk-down must be submitted to SAHRA for comment. No construction activities may commence without comment from SAHRA;
- The Final BAR and EMPr must be submitted to SAHRA via the SAHRIS Case application upon final submission to the relevant competent authority;
- If any evidence of archaeological sites or remains (e.g. remnants of stone-made structures, indigenous ceramics, bones, stone artefacts, ostrich eggshell fragments, charcoal and ash concentrations), fossils or other categories of heritage resources are found during the proposed development, SAHRA APM Unit (Natasha Higgitt/John Gribble 021 462 5402) must be alerted. If unmarked human burials are

1. DEPARTMENTAL MANDATE

The Directorate: Forestry Management (Other Regions) in the Department of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries (DAFF) is responsible for implementation of the **National Forests Act, Act 84 of 1998 (NFA)** and the **National Veld and Forest Fires Act, Act 101 of 1998** as amended. The developer must take note of the following sections of the NFA:

1.1 Section 12(1): "The Minister may declare-

- (a) a particular tree,
- (b) a particular group of trees,
- (c) a particular woodland; or
- (d) trees belonging to a particular species, to be a protected tree, group of trees, woodland or species.

1.2 Section 15(1): "No person may-

- (a) Cut, disturb, damage or destroy any protected tree; or
- (b) Possess, collect, remove, transport, export, purchase, sell, donate or in any other manner acquire or dispose of any protected tree, or any forest product derived from a protected tree, except-
 - (i) under a license granted by the Minister; or
 - (ii) in terms of an exemption from the provision of this subsection published by the Minister in the Gazette on the advice of the Council."

- 1.3 "Any person who contravenes the prohibition on-
- (i) The cutting, disturbance, damage or destruction of temporarily protected trees or groups of trees referred to in section 14(2) or protected trees referred to in section 15(1)(a); or
 - (ii) The possession, collection, removal, transport, export, purchase or sale of temporarily protected trees or groups of trees referred to in section 14(2) or protected trees referred to in section 15(1)(b), or any forest product derived from a temporarily protected tree, group of trees or protected tree, is guilty of a first category offence.
- 1.4 Section 58 (1): "Any person who is guilty of a first category offence referred to in sections 62 and 63 may be sentenced to a fine or imprisonment for a period of up to three years, or to both a fine and such imprisonment."
- 1.5 The list of protected tree species under section 12(1) (d) of the National Forests Act, 1998 (Act No. 84 of 1998) was published in GN1602 of 23 December 2016.

2. COMMENTS ON POST APPLICATION BASIC ASSESSMENT REPORT

- 2.1 Page 21 of the Basic Assessment Report (BAR) refers to the applicable legislation. The Northern Cape Nature Conservation Act, Act 9 of 2009 (NCNCA) was not mentioned, but later on the report stated that seven (7) provincially protected plant species were encountered, thus the NCNCA must be included under applicable legislation. Provincially protected plant species may not be damaged or disturbed without a valid Flora Permit from Nature Conservation.
- 2.2 On page 22, reference is made to the NFA, but it stated that DEA (National) is the administering authority. Kindly note the DAFF (National) is the administering authority, as explained in number 1 above.
- 2.3 Page 31 refers to the affected vegetation type, Ghaap Plateau Vaalbosveld and confirmed that three (3) NFA listed protected tree species are present on the 20 ha site, including Camel thorn *Vachellia erioloba*. It report further stated that "no red list plant species were encountered or is expected..." Kindly note that Camel is listed as Red Data Plant Species with a status of "Declining".
- 2.4 The report stated: "Critical Biodiversity Areas (CBA) or Ecological Support Areas (ESA) has not yet been defined for this Municipal area." Please note the draft CBA map is available for the Northern Cape Province. For a link to the map, please contact the provincial Department of Environment and Nature Conservation (DENC). The report stated on page 40 that it is considered unlikely that the proposed footprint will fall within any CBA or ESA. Kindly ensure that the site is overlaid on the draft CBA map to confirm that it does not fall in a CBA or ESA as indicated on page 35 of the report.

3. COMMENTS ON REVISED SPECIALIST BIODIVERSITY ASSESSMENT AND BOTANICAL SCAN

3.1 Page 9 refers to the NFA List of protected tree species, specifically GN 908 of 21 November 2014. Kindly note the list of protected tree species is published annually. See number 1.5 above.

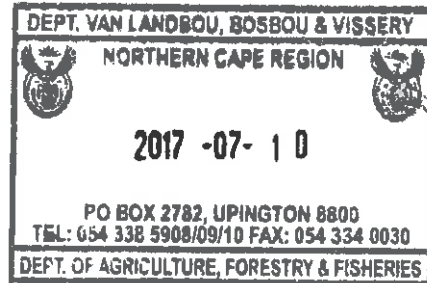
3.2 Page 11 confirmed there are one (1) *Boscia albitrunca*; four (4) *Vachellia erioloba* and scattered *Vachellia haematoxylon* on site that may be affected by the proposed solar energy facility. The developer must apply for a Forest Act License prior to disturbance of any of the NFA Listed protected tree species on site, if such species cannot be avoided during construction. Trees that can be avoided should be clearly marked and demarcated during construction to protect it from accidental harm and destruction.

The SAHRA Archaeology, Palaeontology and Meteorites (APM) Unit has no objections to the proposed development. The recommendations of the heritage specialist and the following conditions must be included in the EMPr for the project:

- If any evidence of archaeological sites or remains (e.g. remnants of stone-made structures, indigenous ceramics, bones, stone artefacts, ostrich eggshell fragments, charcoal and ash concentrations), fossils or other categories of heritage resources are found during the proposed development, SAHRA APM Unit (Natasha Higgitt/John Gribble 021 462 5402) must be alerted. If unmarked human burials are uncovered, the SAHRA Burial Grounds and Graves (BGG) Unit (Mimi Seetelo 012 320 8490), must be alerted immediately. A professional archaeologist or palaeontologist, depending on the nature of the finds, must be contracted as soon as possible to inspect the findings. If the newly discovered heritage resources prove to be of archaeological or palaeontological significance, a Phase 2 rescue operation may be required subject to permits issued by SAHRA; and
- If the development receives an Environmental Authorisation (EA), SAHRA must be informed and all documents pertaining to the EA must be uploaded to the SAHRIS Case file.
