Heritage Process: Proposed Establishment of a 25m Mast at Edcon

Background

In June 2018, a Desktop Heritage Screening Assessment was conducted to determine the

likely impacts of the proposed 55m mast on heritage resources based on all existing

information about this area available on SAHRIS - the South African Heritage Resources

Information System.

Legislative Context

The proposed development triggers section 38(8) of the National Heritage Resources Act

(Act 25 of 1999) which states that: "The provisions of this section do not apply to a

development as described in subsection (1) if an evaluation of the impact of such

development on heritage resources is required in terms of the Environment Conservation

Act, 1989 (Act No. 73 of 1989), or the integrated environmental management guidelines

issued by the Department of Environment Affairs and Tourism, or the Minerals Act, 1991 (Act

No. 50 of 1991), or any other legislation: Provided that the consenting authority must

ensure that the evaluation fulfils the requirements of the relevant heritage resources

authority in terms of subsection (3), and any comments and recommendations of the

relevant heritage resources authority with regard to such development have been

taken into account prior to the granting of the consent."
