



Background Information Document for the Proposed 30m High Telecommunications Mast on Portion 17 of Farm Koopmans Kloof 221, Brackenfell, Cape Town

CapeNature would like to thank you for the opportunity to comment on the proposed development and would like to make the following comments. Please note that our comments only pertain to the biodiversity related impacts and not to the overall desirability of the proposed development.

The property on which the development is proposed is classified as No Natural according to the Biodiversity Network (BioNet) for the City of Cape Town and the Western Cape Biodiversity Spatial Plan. The historical Google Earth imagery indicates that the site has been cultivated across its entire extent within the last 10 years, although only a portion is currently cultivated. No terrestrial ecological specialist studies are therefore considered necessary, as the only natural vegetation which is likely to occur are weedy pioneers of no conservation value.

According to the BioNet, three artificial dams are mapped on the site, with one in the centre and two located in the south west. NFEPA has additionally mapped natural wetlands adjacent to the artificial dams. It is therefore preferred that a freshwater specialist study is undertaken, unless sufficient evidence can be provided that the proposed footprint will not be located in or adjacent to a wetland.

CapeNature will comment in more detail on the Draft Basic Assessment Report, however we are unlikely to object to this application.

CapeNature reserves the right to revise initial comments and request further information based on any additional information that may be received.


