Dear Inge,

Many thanks for informing me of this. Please find my response below:

- The competent heritage authority (HWC) has agreed that no heritage resources are likely to be impacted by the proposed development.

- **Comment: "It is noted that the Heritage Screener Document focuses mostly on heritage resources related to archaeology".**

I would disagree - the HS covers impacts to all heritage resources including archaeology, built environment, cultural landscapes and palaeontology

- **Comment: "The NID submission did not reflect the site in relation to the Agter Paarl/Paardeberg Cultural Landscape, Klipheuwel Radio Station, or the Koeberg/Swartland Farms Cultural Landscape within the larger landscape".**

The HS and NID are NOT intended to be heritage impact assessments. The role of the NID and HS is to determine the likelihood of the proposed development impacting on significant heritage resources. The CoCT has not identified the area in which the telecommunications mast is proposed to be built as a heritage landscape of any significance (see attached image). In addition, the proposed 25m mast will not impact at all on the Agter Paarl/Paardeberg Cultural Landscape or the Koeberg/Swartland Farms Cultural Landscape, as noted in the HS: "The proposed telecommunications mast is not likely to impact on any significant or pristine cultural landscape as the proposed telecommunications mast is intended to be located away from any street frontage on private property and will be minimally visible to the public."

As far as we are able to ascertain from the publicly available information, the Klipheuwel Radio Station has not been identified as a heritage resource. Lastly, the Klipheuwel Radio Station is located approximately 2.5km away from the proposed telecommunications mast and as such, the proposed mast will have no impact.
