CONFIRMATION OF GENERAL AUTHORISATION IN TERMS OF SECTION 39 OF THE NATIONAL WATER ACT 1998 (ACT 36 OF 1998) FOR IMPEDING THE FLOW OF WATER IN A WATERCOURSE (SECTION 21 (C)) AND ALTERING THE BED, BANKS, COURSE OR CHARACTERISTICS OF A WATERCOURSE (SECTION 21 (I)) WATER USES: MAXWELL FAMITY TRUST- PORTION 7 OF THE FARM JAGERSVLAKTE 292, CALEDON DIVISION.

The Breede-Gouritz Catchment Management Agency has evaluated the submitted documents and hereby confirm that the water use falls within the ambit of the General Authorisation, Government Gazette 40229 dated 26 August 2016. Therefore, you may continue with the water use as permissible in terms of Section 22 (1) (a) (iii) of National Water Act, 1998. Details of the water uses registered appear on Table 1.

The use of water is subject to the conditions as set out in Government Notice No.509 dated 26 August 2016 and the following:

- 1. The mitigation measures as stipulated in the Freshwater Report dated January 2019 must be implemented.
- 2. The water use must not detrimentally affect the use of water of any other lawful water user, including the environment.
- 3. Construction should take place during the summer months, when the flow is low.

This authorisation is in terms of the National Water Act, 1998 (Act 36 of 1998). If the activity require Environmental Authorisation in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act

107 of 1998) then this must be obtained by the water user before commencement of the activity. Please consult the Department of Environmental Affairs and Development Planning in this regard.

Please note that the DW Forms will be forwarded for capturing on the Water Authorization and Registration Management System (WARMS) whereupon a registration certificate will be issued. Please note that the registration capturing process can take up to three months.

This office reserves the right to amend and revise its comments as well as to request any further information. The onus remains with the registered property owner to confirm adherence to any other relevant legislation that any activities might trigger and/or need authorization.
