





The proposed development entails the upgrade of the existing Hopetown waste water treatment works. It is proposed that the existing outfall bulk sewage line be replaced with a new sewage line, consisting of a 315mm diameter uPVC pipe with a length of approximately 2117m. The route of the proposed new pipeline will differ slightly and be will be longer, when compared to the existing line. This is to allow sewage to gravitate from settlements to the treatments works and eliminate pumping stations. The proposed development footprint is expected to be approximately 2.5ha. The proposed pipeline will cross various drainage lines which has been subjected to disturbances. Vegetation in the area consist of dwarf shrubland is not protected in terms of the "National Environmental Management Biodiversity Act 2004, National List of Ecosystems that are threatened and in need of protection".

Description of Alternatives:

Alternative includes layout options and the option of not proceeding with the proposed development (the No-Go option) will be discussed in the application process.
