Good morning Schalk,

Thank you for the feedback over the phone this morning. Could you kindly confirm that you are happy with option 3 below:

There are three options regarding the Municipality's requirements for a peripheral surveillance road for Calcutta:

1. Have a road run completely around the whole erf immediately adjacent to the fence/wall ... I assume the fence will be on the erf boundary?

This is a bit of overkill particularly on the northern/entrance section of the property since there is already an access road running along that edge. This is not the preferred option since it involves forming a road through the wetland you mentioned as well as another river crossing.

2. Have the road run along the eastern and southern boundaries but not along the western (R304) side since the area can be viewed from the R304 or road reserve external to the property. The northern boundary may be inspected from the main access road. It is preferred that the road be access controlled (boom gate?) for Municipal maintenance vehicles with a turning circle at the end (in the south).

The advantages of this option are that we avoid making a road through the wetland to the north west of the property which also has aesthetic implications.

3. The last option is basically the same as '2' above except that we extend the road along the western/R304 boundary up to just south of the north western wetland region where we make a turning circle (maybe even with some form of feature/sculpture by a local artist in the middle of the circle since it will be visible from the R304).

Vivienne, good day.

Your below questions refer:

1. Will the Municipality service the site in terms of domestic waste removal? Yes (Saliem Haider [Solid Waste] cc'ed)

2. At this stage, I am not sure if water borne sewage or a septic tank will be utilised for the operational site. Should a septic tank option be employed, will the Municipality service the emptying of the tank on an ad-hoc basis if necessary? Both sites will have to be services with septic tanks (Esias de Jager [Water Services] cc'ed). The municipality will have to appoint a service provider to service the tanks. Culcatta has a pipeline to which the site (water for domestic use / not irrigation) can be connected. Louw's Bos' water-network will have to be developed to connect to a pipeline in the vicinity.
