

Proposed VGK Knysna 25m Telecommunications Tree Mast Development

Description

Orange square indicates development footprint which lies within Erf. 3244, 35 Vigilance Drive, Hornlee, Knysna, Western Cape. Erf. 3244 belongs to the Verenigende Gereformeerde Kerk (VGK) and the property contains a church building and has been totally transformed. The proposed development footprint of approximately 112square meters, lies within the church property on the eastern corner. The erf is zoned institutional and is well within an urban area. As indicated on the map, the proposed development site does not fall within a CBA, ESA or nationally protected area (formal or informal).
