Note that CapeNature has previously provided commented to the Overstrand Municipality (see attached), and noted that significant biodiversity impacts are unlikely. CapeNature would like to thank you for the opportunity to comment on the application and would like to make the following comments. Please note that our comments only pertain to the biodiversity-related impacts and not to the overall desirability of the application. The application is for the permanent departure and consent use for a 22 m high telecommunications mast on FA S87/14, Hemel en Aarde Valley, Hermanus. Elim Ferricrete Fynbos (critically endangered) would have occurred on site; however, according to satellite imagery and the Western Cape Biodiversity Spatial Plan (CapeNature 2017), no natural vegetation remains. The site is significantly buffered from the Onrus River and its associated seep wetlands by more than 130 m.	CapeNature
