

SA kampioenskapstydrenne terug in die Wes-Kaap

Die Overberg- Grand Prix word hierdie naweek as die eerste ronde van die Suid-Afrikaanse nasionale tydrenkampioenskap en tweede ronde van die Wes-Kaapse tydrenkampioenskap aangebied.

Die eerste tydren vir plaaslike geesdriftiges vanjaar was die Darling-tydren die eerste naweek in Maart, en die laaste nasionale kampioenskapstydren was die Toyota Kaap-handelaarstydren in September 2016.

Plaaslike tydrenaanhangers wat wil kyk hoe passasiersmotors teen nekbreekspoed op plaaspaaië tussen koringlande jaag soos motoriste op die N2 maar net kan droom om te doen, kry van môre af (Vrydag en Saterdag 29 en 30 Maart) weer die geleentheid.

Een plaaslike jaer – die jong Paul-Hendrik Franken van Gansbaai en sy navigator, Hilton Auffrey – kan hierdie naweek 'n doring in die vlees van die “grootkokkedoor”- nasionale spanne wees, onder wie Toyota se fabrieksjagers, Guy Botteril en Simon Vacey-Lyle, in hul Etios R2N, wat deur dieselfde span wat die Dakar-Hilux ontwikkel het, gebou is. Franken-hulle, die naasweners van die Darling-tydren, die openingsronde van die Wes-Kaapse tydrenkampioenskap, kan nie net onder die ses nasionale inskrywings eindig nie, maar het 'n baie goeie kans om die hele renveld in hul turbo-aangedrewe VW Polo met 'n eenliter-driesilinder-enjin te klop.

Die ervare nasionale jaer AC Potgieter en sy navigator, Nico Swartz, jaag ook in 'n nuwe turboaangejaagde eenliter-Polo soortgelyk aan dié van Franken. Die motor is die ene onbekendhede, maar 'n mens kan aanneem dat Volkswagen nie hierdie dapper stap sou doen as VW

Motorsport nie daarvan oortuig was dat die turboaangejaagde driesilinder-Polo by die turbolose 1,6-liter-Etios kan bly nie.

Potgieter se ervaring kan hom dalk help om sy voet lig genoeg te hou om nie die nuwe motor in sy eerste ren te breek nie, maar hard genoeg neersit om die Etios van die verdedigende kampioene te klop.

Die nasionalekampioenskapsjaers sluit ook die klassieke sowel as die Open 2- en Open 4- ope klasse in, waar ook vierwielaangedrewe voertuie soos die Yaris- en RunX-S2000's en twee Subaru WRX STI's te sien sal wees. Open 2 is die grootste klas in die byeenkoms met altesaam 10 motors, wat talle WP-jaers insluit.

Asof dit nie reeds genoeg is nie, word die Overberg- Grand Prix gekenmerk deur 'n aantal interessante en unieke inskrywings:

- Die 71-jarige Andy Haigh-Smith van die Malmesbury-omgewing is die oudste aktiewe tydrenjaer in Suid-Afrika (net 'n paar maande jonger as die legendariese Sarel van der Merwe wat in Desember verlede jaar 72 geword het), en jaag in sy laaste seisoen saam met die jong Tania Vermaak van Strand. Dié twee is die verdedigende Wes-Kaapse provinsiale tydrenkampioene (Mitsubishi Lancer GT).
- Die 2018- klassieke klas-kampioen Etienne Malherbe sal plaaslike tydrentoekouers ouder gewoonte met sy dwars-deur-die-draaie-jaagstyl in sy Datsun 160U SSS vermaak en kan sy klas straks wen;
- Een van die skouspelagtigste deelnemers aan plaaslike tydrenne, Johny Gemmel, en sy navigator, Carl Peskin, het hul Porsche aan die byeenkoms onttrek nadat Gemmel se pa verlede week oorlede is.

EnviroAfrica cc has been appointed, to undertake the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) for the proposed project HN Schoeman en Vennote was appointed to conduct the Water Use Licence Application (WULA).

Project Description & Location: (33° 30' 35.52" S, 18° 54' 40.22" E)
The proposed development entails the increase in height of the existing Zwartfontein dam wall with 2.3m. The existing dam wall height is ±11.7m and with the increase the maximum dam wall height will be 14m. The increase if the dam wall height will result in an increase of the dam's total footprint from 3.8ha to 5ha (1.2ha increase). The current dam capacity is at 160 000m³ and will be increased to 268 000m³. An existing water use for the taking of water exists, water is pumped from the Berg River. The dam will be located on agricultural land.

Description of Alternatives:
Alternative includes layout options and the option of not proceeding with the proposed development (the No-Go option) will be discussed in the application process.
