The proposed agricultural development and expansion of vineyards on an existing farm on Portion 13 of Orange Falls Farm No. 16, Augrabies Falls Way, Augrabies, Northern Cape, includes activities listed in terms of the NEMA EIA Regulations 2014. EnviroAfrica cc has been appointed by The Lair Trust, to undertake the NEMA Application for Environmental Authorisation process.

Project Description & Location:

Its is proposed that an area of 5 ha of vegetation be cleared for the proposed development of new vineyard with a development footprint of 5 ha. Its is proposed that a new dam be developed with a combined storage capacity of less than 50 000m³. This dam will be located on the north-eastern part of the property. An additional area of 14 ha be cleared of vegetation to allow for dryland agricultural activities. No roads will be constructed as existing farm dirt roads will be used to gain access to the proposed site. The site is approximately 9km north-west of the town of Augrabies. The total development footprint will not exceed 20 ha. The site co-ordinates are **28°39'42.28"S**, **20°20'22.42"E**.
