gewoonlik teen ongeveer 20:00 plaas wanneer die uitslae ook aangekondig word.

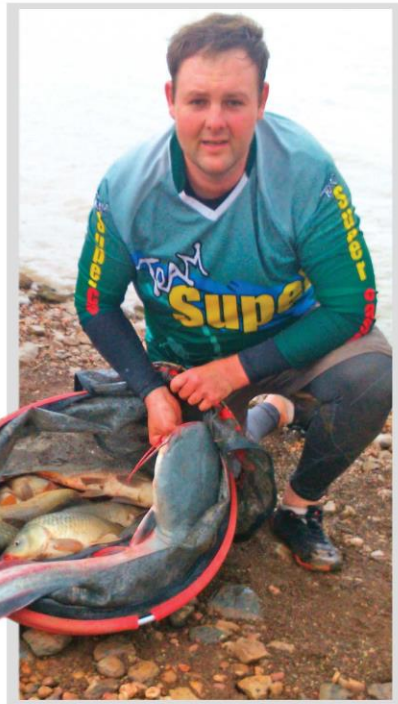
Die klub verkoop ligte etes terwyl die wedstryde gespeel word en 'n kontantkroeg is ook beskikbaar.
