APPLICATION TO REGISTER FOR THE VISSERSPAN SOLAR PV FACILITY PROJECT
1.

The following farmers are herewith applying to register to take part in the Environmental Impact Assessment for the farm Visserspan, identified as “Solar PV Facility”.

Contact details as well as names of the parties concerned are enclosed. We request that all correspondence and important information should be sent to each of these parties individually from now on, since this letter only serves as a coordinated effort to ensure that all farmers are registered in time.

This is the third solar development close to Dealesville in the Free State. The premises identified for these developments are almost adjacent. The impact studies for the first two were done by the CSIR and the one for Visserspan will now be done by EnviroAfrica. However, because the three developments are so close to one another, it simply does not make sense to do the impact studies in isolation. The combined impact of all the developments on the environment is dramatically different from that indicated by the individual impact studies.

Because the developments are so close to one another, the same farmers will be negatively impacted by all of them. Apart from the wider impact on the town of Dealesville and its direct environment, the collective effect of the developments on an area already compromised by Eskom power developments is completely ignored. These developments are going to have a catastrophic effect on agricultural activities in the area, and by implication, on the farmers involved.

As part of the impact study we would like to voice our concerns regarding the negative impact of the development on the area and provide reasons why the area is not viable for any of the developments. Criteria currently used by developers to justify their choice of the specific area around Dealesville, are exactly the strongest arguments among the farmers why it is not suitable for any further power developments.

No private development can be sanctioned if it is to the detriment of other people's careers and livelihood. None of the developments are undertaken

because they are of national importance; they are undertaken by private developers solely to make money in the process.

Should any additional information be needed, we would be glad to co-operate.

The following is my inputs to you:

Uniqueness of Power/electricity

The authority must clearly identified the type of electricity generated to us consumers. This natural power (from sun, wind or environment) should be disclosed to public as its continued harvest does not require huge cost like buying items to produce power.

Pricing structure
