The Directorate: Biodiversity Conservation reviewed and evaluated the aforementioned draft report. Based on the information provided in the DBAR, the study area is located within the Critical Biodiversity Area (CBA1) and Ecological Support Area (ESA); Therefore, the proposed development would result in the loss of Vaal-Vet Sandy grassland which is listed as a threatened ecosystem (Endangered A1) in the National List of Threatened Ecosystems.

The botanist in the conclusion of the study highlighted that "although the study area is in an area classified and mapped as a CBA1 area, my findings were that the area does not warrant CBA1 status and is suitable for building a solar PV installation". This statement is confusing, please elaborate further in the final report and also obtain comments from the provincial department and or any conservation agencies to confirm whether they are in agreement with the specialist as they are the custodianship of biodiversity in the Free State Province.

Based on the information provided the Directorate Biodiversity Conservation is of the view that the proposed Visserspan 1 solar PV facility will result in fatal flaw since projects sites cover major part of an

area designated as highly sensitive and according to the specialist the degraded areas are no longer degraded since they have successfully reverted to Vaal-Vet Sandy Grassland (good condition) In conclusion; the development within an areas classified as CBA1 is not supported.
