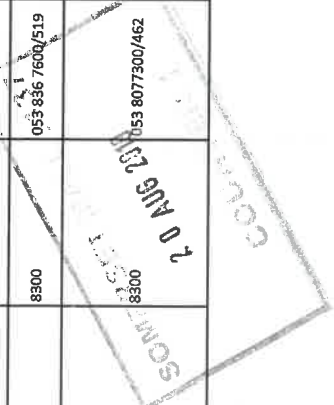

EnviroAfrica cc has been appointed by undertake the Environmental Impact Assessment for the proposed project. WATSAN Africa was appointed to apply for a Water Use Licence.

**Project Description & Location:** 29°48'10.74"S 17°29'43.15"E

Komaggas is situated in the Nama Khoi Municipal Area in the Northern Cape Province. The increase in demand for proper housing in Komaggas has led to an increased demand for drinking water. The proposed project aims to upgrade the water supply system of the town of Komaggas. The upgrade will consist of the refurbishment of existing boreholes, the equipment for new boreholes and the upgrading and installation of associated infrastructure. The scope of work also consists of the construction of a new concrete reservoir, the construction of new water supply pipelines as well as the construction of electricity supply lines to the new boreholes. The proposed project falls within a critical biodiversity area. Various drainage lines were observed on site.

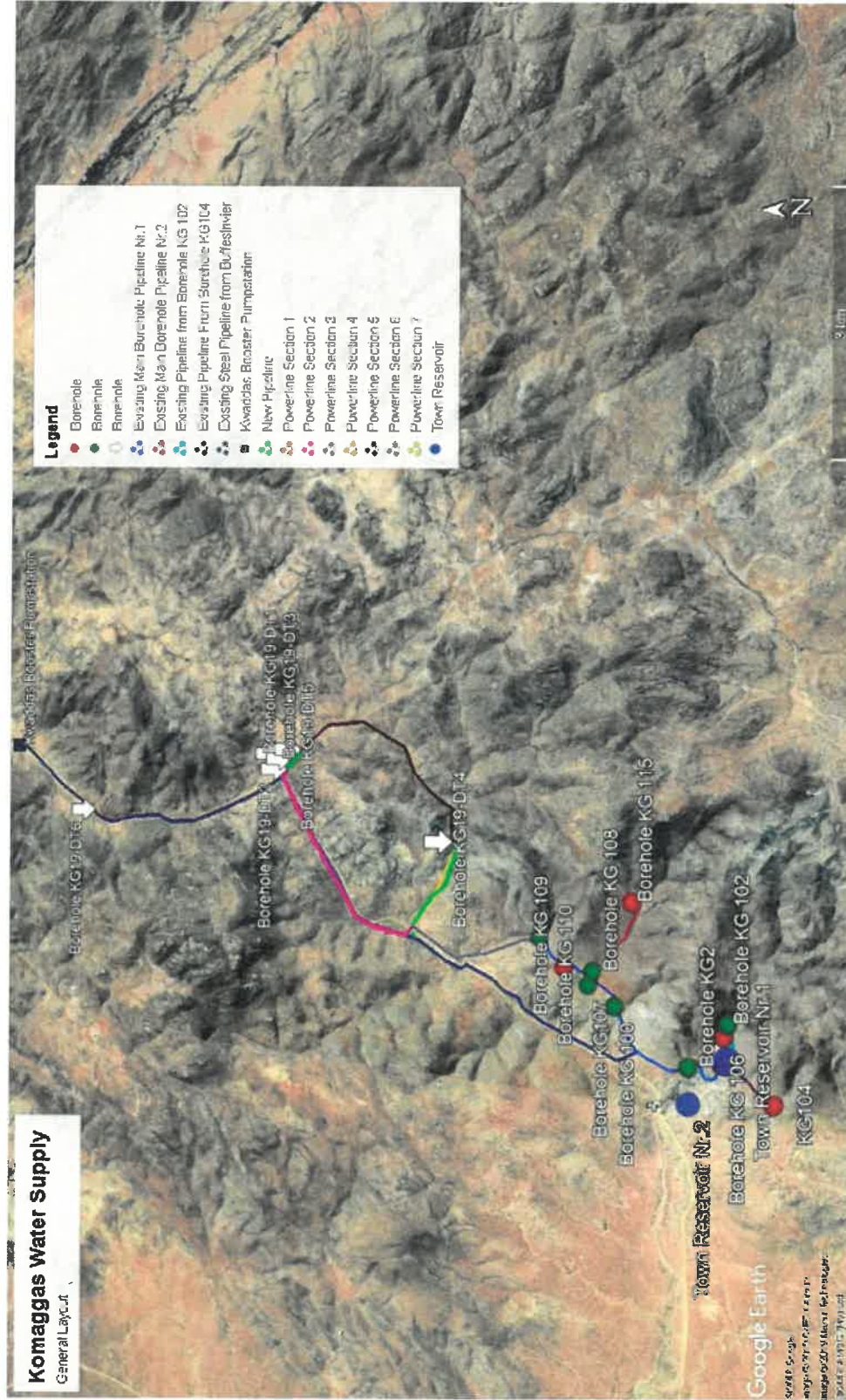
#### Description of Alternatives:
