The Proposed Development of a 35m High Telecommunication Mast on Portion 22 of Farm 22, Zouterivier, Western Cape and includes activities listed in terms of the NEMA EIA Regulations, 2014.

EnviroAfrica cc has been appointed by CTC Towers (Pty) Ltd. to undertake the NEMA EIA Application for Environmental Authorisation process.

Project Description & Location:

A 35m high telecommunication mast, including associated infrastructure, is proposed on Portion 22 of Farm 22, Zouterivier, Western Cape. The site is situated within the Ward 32 of the City of Cape Town Metropolitan Municipality. The proposed development includes the clearance of an area of less than 100m² for the construction of a 35m high telecommunication mast and associated infrastructure. The mast base station will be enclosed with a 2.4m high steel palisade fence for safety and security reasons. The mast and base station will have four equipment containers for future clients and will have an access gate. The site coordinates are **33°36'22.90"S; 18°35'34.49"E**.

Public Participation: Interested and Affected Parties ("I&APs") are hereby notified of the application and invited to register (in writing) and/or provide initial comments and identify any issues, concerns or opportunities relating to this project to the contact details provided below, **on or before 25th February 2021**.
