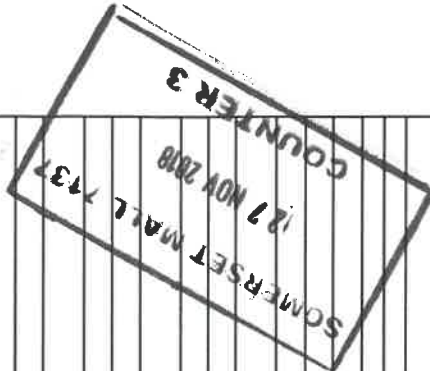

NEMA PUBLIC PARTICIPATION PROCESS

PROPOSED AGRICULTURAL DEVELOPMENT, FARMS 1763, 2372 AND 2363, KAKAMAS SOUTH SETTLEMENT, KAI! GARIB MUNICIPALITY

Notice is hereby given of the intention to submit a NEMA application and a Water Use License Application (WULA), and the public participation process, in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998), as amended ("NEMA"), Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations 2014 and the National Water Act, 1998 (Act No. 36 of 1998). The proposed agricultural development on Farms 1763, 2372 and 2363, Kakamas includes activities listed in terms of the NEMA EIA Regulations 2014.

EnviroAfrica cc has been appointed by the Verneuk Pan Trust to undertake the NEMA Application for Environmental Authorisation process.

Application for environmental authorization to undertake the following activities in terms of NEMA EIA Regulations 2014:

- Government Notice R327 (Listing Notice 1): Activity No. **12, 13, 14, 19, 27**
- Government Notice R325 (Listing Notice 2): Activity No. **15**
- Government Notice R324 (Listing Notice 3): Activity No. **2, 10, 12, 14**

Project Description & Location:

It is proposed that approximately 250ha of land be considered for additional irrigation on Farms 1763, 2372 and 2363, situated in the Kakamas South Settlement. The development will also include the construction of associated infrastructure for irrigation purposes and for the various crops that could be cultivated. Irrigation water will be sourced from the proposed new Kakamas WWTW once constructed and operational.

Site co-ordinates: 28° 48' 12.12" S, 20° 32' 53.43" E.

Public Participation:

- will be notified of the applicant's intention to appeal the decision of the competent authority, together with an indication of where and for what period the appeal submission will be available for inspection.
