

Inwoner praat oor verkragting deur bendeledede

DRIE bendeledede van Ceres is einde Oktober skuldig bevind aan die verkragting van 'n 28-jarige man.

Hul vonnisplegging sou op **3 Desember** plaasgevind het maar dit is na **7 Februarie 2022** uitgestel in afwagting van 'n verslag - een van die veroordeeldes was 17 jaar oud toe die misdryf in 2017 plaasgevind het.

Inwoner praat

Die ingetoë en verfynde M* (28) van Bella Vista is twee keer in sy lewe wreid verkrag deur die Ford Boys-bende.

In dié woonbuurt word mans soos hy deur homofobiese elemente "moffies", "mannenvroue" en ander beleidende name toegesnou en soms loop hulle deur onder geweld en ook verkragting.

M is die eerste keer in Maart 2017 wreid aangerand en verkrag, maar weens die vernedering wat hy deurgemaak het en sy skaamte as die gemeenskap daarvan sou hoor, het hy daaroor geswyg.

Toe bendeledede hom weke na dié voorval weer verkrag, het hy besluit tot hier toe en nie verder nie.

Hy het besluit om uit te praat.

Hy skryf dit toe aan die geloof van sy familie, sy ma se gebede en die aktivistegroep *Triangle Project* dat drie mans gearresteer en aangekla is van ontvoering en verkragting.

Rodney Beukes, Austin Fritz en Peter John (PJ) Adams, lede van die Ford Boys-bende, is einde Oktober skuldig bevind.

M sê hy glo hy is geteiken omdat hy gay is. Sy drie aanvallers het hom in Augustus 2017 aan sy ponyster getrek uit 'n erf waar hy

gekuier het, en hom toe verkrag. M sê hy was "hysterics" ná die voorval. Hy het gevrees die selfde lot wag op hom as wat sy beste vriend, David Olyn, oorgekom het.

Olyn is in 2014 in Bella Vista deur Christo Oncker vermoor. Oncker het daardie dag vir kinders wat groototgoed daar gestaan het, gesê hy gaan 'n "moffie doodmaak".

Hy het Olyn by 'n geboutjie ingeneem, met 'n baksteen oor die kop geslaan, op hom gespring en agterna die gebou aan die brand gesteek. Oncker dien tans 17 jaar tronkstraf uit.

Omkoop

Die verdagtes het M probeer omkoop om die klagte teen hulle terug te trek, maar hy was vasbeslotte om deur te druk. Hy sê die drie het 'n deel van hom geneem wat hy nie meer sal terugkry nie.

"Dit het my só aangeraak, dis hoekom ek hierdie saak tot die einde wil sien."

Hy is 'n introvert en hoop sy saak praat hard met Bella Vista oor die feit dat aanvaarding van gays 'n groot uitdaging bly.

Ná die verkragting het M na 'n veilige plek uitgewyk waar hy hom as geleenthedsbeplanner uitleef, maar veral belangrik, waar hy in veiligheid kan bly.

Sharon Cox van Triangle Project sê dié organisasie het M regdeur die saak ondersteun. Cox sê skuldigbevindings in sake van verkragting van mans is soms moeilik. "Mediese studente moet ook beter opgelei word om manlike slagoffers van verkragting te hanteer," sê sy.

Notice is hereby given of the intention to submit a NEMA application and the public participation process, in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998), as amended ("NEMA"), Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations 2014, as well as a Water Use License Application in terms of the National Water Act (Act 36 of 1998) (NWA). The proposed bridge and road upgrade includes activities listed in terms of the NEMA EIA Regulations 2014.

EnviroAfrica cc has been appointed by Doornkraal Investments (Pty) Ltd to undertake the NEMA application process for Environmental Authorisation.

Application for environmental authorization to undertake the following activities in terms of NEMA EIA Regulations 2014:

Project Description & Location: It is proposed that a new bridge be constructed over the Olifants River using pre-cast concrete culverts, placed upstream of the existing bridge. The proposed bridge will be 7.5m wide, and approximately 50m in length. The road on either side of the bridge will also be realigned (approximately 130m). An additional 495m of the entrance road will need to be realigned (three separate sections) to allow interlink trucks better access to the farm. The new road sections will be approximately 5m wide, with an 8m road reserve.

The new bridge will be located on Portion 3 of Farm Visgat 207. The road realignments will be located on Portion 3 of Farm Visgat 207 and Portion 2 of Farm 304. Site co-ordinates: Bridge: 33° 04' 36.54"S 19° 13' 00.36"E
