



Good afternoon Simone,

I hope all is well.

We are currently in the stage of preparing the Application Form and Draft Scoping Report for submission to the competent authority [Department of Environment and Nature Conservation (DENC)] and Registered Interested and Affected Parties (I&APs) for their comment. We have received the Final Layout (revised map including existing and proposed development) which we are incorporating into the Draft Scoping Report and are awaiting design drawings for the pumpstation. Some of the appendices need to be amended to include the newly demarcated areas as per the Final Layout (as maps and previously prepared appendices were based on the initial map received).

#### **Going Forward**:

Once the Application and Draft Scoping Report have been completed, the Draft Scoping Report will be made available to Registered I&APs for a legislated 30-day comment period. Once the 30-day comment period has ended, the Final Scoping Report will be prepared and submitted to the DENC for acceptance / acceptance on condition(s). The DENC then have a legislated 43-day timeframe to accept the Final Scoping Report. Comments received from any I&AP will be incorporated into the Final Scoping Report and addressed during the following stage of the environmental process (please see below).

Once the Final Scoping Report has been accepted / accepted on condition, the Draft Environmental Impact Report (EIR) will be submitted to the DENC. This report will detail the findings of the specialist studies, include assessments of identified potential impacts, and address any comments raised by the DENC and/or Registered I&APs during the previous Scoping Phases. The Draft EIR will be made available to Registered I&APs for a legislated 30-day comment period.

Once this comment period has ended, the Final EIR will be prepared for submission. The Final EIR addresses any comments raised by the DENC and/or Registered I&APs on the Draft EIR and any amendments which need to be made to the EIR based on comments received. The Final EIR will then be submitted to the DENC for their final decision (approval / refusal of Environmental Authorisation) where the DENC have a legislated timeframe of 107 days to make their final decision.

As outlined above, the submission timeframes of any report depend on the number and type of comments raised by the DENC and/or Registered I&APs, as well as the depth of response required. Another factor influencing the submission time frame of the reports are the time taken for the DENC to respond (accept /approve) to the submitted forms, especially at the Final Scoping Stage where the Final Scoping Report must be accepted by the DENC prior to continuing with the Draft EIR stage.

We will however be preparing the next report during the commenting period of the previously submitted report (i.e., prepare the draft EIR once the Final Scoping Report has been submitted) to expedite the process wherever possible.



The EAP needs to take cognisance of this fact in all statements regarding mitigation of the NO- Go Alternative impact. The landowner is legally required to remove all alien plants from the farms and therefore the No-Go Alternative has to rake into account.

☐ In addition to CARA, in terms of the Alien Invasive Species Regulations. NEM:BA, 2014, specific alien plant species (e.g. Prosopis aladulosa) are either prohibited or listed as a restricted activity concerning their spread. All alien trees present on the properties should be removed as they are a propagate source for further spread of invasive alien plants. It should also however be noted that although brush cutting vegetation is permissible, the frequency of such activities should not exceed thresholds that would result in the succession of the vegetation unit.

The proponent must provide suitable measures for the loss of the Boschia albitruncas. Considering the ecological impacts and the loss of a ecological keystone specie (transplanting of the specie is not viable), the proponent must provide counterbalance measures whether in a form offset/compensation. This matter should be robustly assessed and discussed with DFFE and DEARL in order to make an informed decision as well for permitting requirements.

Efforts must be made to relocated reptiles, ground dwelling animals and bird nests out of the construction footprint to areas that are not affected by the development to minimise
