MATZIKAMA: Die Santa Shoebox-projek het in 2006 in Kaapstad ontstaan met 'n nederige 180 skoendose. In 15 jaar het dit met rasse skrede gegroei, met 'n totaal van 1 017 741 skoendose wat geskenk word. Die skoendose word jaarliks versprei na meer as 1000 ontvangsfasiliteite deur meer as 60 satellietstasies in Suid-Afrika en Namibië.

Die sukses van die projek kan grootliks toegeskryf word aan die persoonlike aard daarvan - skenkers gee geskenke van noodsaaklike items en lekkernye aan kinders wie se name, ouderdomme en geslagte bekend is. Die minimum 8 benodigde items is 'n tandeborsel, tandepasta, seep, 'n waslap, lekkers, 'n speelding, skoolbenodigdhede en 'n kledingstuk - alles nuut, ongebruik en ouderdoms geskik. Die projek word ondersteun deur 'n uitgebreide netwerk van vrywilligers in Suid-Afrika en Namibië-goedhartige mense wat vrylik van hul tyd, energie en kundigheid gee sonder vergoeding. Hulle maak ook staat op die ruimhartige steun van verskillende korporatiewe borge wat geldelike of pro bono-steun belowe. Baie ondernemings wat hul personele betrek, maak Santa Shoeboxes deel van hul pro-

gramme vir maatskaplike beleggings vir ondernemings.

Notice is hereby given of the intention to submit a Section 24G Application for the unlawful development of an in-stream dam on Portion 188 of Farm Melkboom 384 (Vanrhynsdorp RD), near Trawal, without the required environmental authorisation, and the public participation process in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998), as amended ("NEMA"), Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations 2014. The development of an in-stream dam on Portion 188 of Farm Melkboom 384 constitutes an unlawful activity in contravention of Section 24F(1) of the NEMA, and includes activities listed in terms of the NEMA EIA Regulations, 2014 (as amended).

EnviroAfrica cc has been appointed by Winterfresh Farming (Pty) Ltd, to undertake the Section 24G Application for Environmental Authorisation process. Watsan Africa has been appointed by Winterfresh Farming (Pty) Ltd, to undertake the Water Use License Application in terms of the National Water Act (Act 36 of 1998).
