NEMA PUBLIC PARTICIPATION PROCESS

THE PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT OF A DAM ON FARM KLEINVLEI 209, PORTION 1, CERES, WESTERN CAPE

Notice is hereby given of the intention to submit a NEMA application and the public participation process, in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998), as amended ("NEMA"), Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations 2014, as well as a Water Use License Application in terms of the National Water Act (Act 36 of 1998)(NWA). The proposed Kleinvlei dam includes activities listed in terms of the NEMA EIA Regulations 2014.

EnviroAfrica cc has been appointed by TSR Boerdery (Pty) Ltd. to undertake the NEMA application process for Environmental Authorisation.

Application for environmental authorization to undertake the following activities in terms of NEMA EIA Regulations 2014:

Project Description & Location:

It is proposed that a dam be constructed on Farm Kleinvlei 209, Portion 1. The dam wall will have a height of 7m and a length of approximately 135m. The dam will have a capacity of 235 000m³, and will have a surface area of approximately 12.1ha. The site is located approximately 25km north of Prince Alfred Hamlet, off the R303. Site co-ordinates: 33° 04' 01.04" S, 19° 19' 58.53" E.
