SECTION 24G APPLICATION FOR THE UNLAWFUL CONSTRUCTION OF A DEVELOPMENT WITHIN 100M OF THE HIGH-WATER MARK OF AN ESTUARY ON PORTION 9 OF FARM VERMAAKLIKHEID 499 AND PORTION 3 OF FARM KLEINEFONTEIN 503, VERMAAKLIKHEID, RIVERSDALE

Notice is hereby given of the intention to submit an application, and the public participation, process in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998), as amended ("NEMA"), Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations 2014. The unlawful development within 100m of the high-water mark (HWM) of the Duiwenhoks River (estuary), and the installation of a floating dock/jetty on the bank of the Duiwenhoks River on Portion 3 of Farm Kleinefontein No. 503, Vermaaklikheid, Western Cape. The unlawful activities are in contravention of Section 24F of the NEMA, and includes activities listed in terms of the NEMA EIA Regulations, 2010 and 2014.

EnviroAfrica cc has been appointed by Mr. Jonathan Gersh, to undertake the Section 24G Application for Environmental Authorisation process.

Application for environmental authorization to undertake the following activities*:

Government Notice R544 (Listing Notice 1 of 2010): Activities 16 and 18.
Government Notice R327 (Listing Notice 1 of 2014): Activities 17 and 19A.

*Please note that should the listed activities above change or additional activities be identified during the course of the NEMA Application process, registered I&APs will be notified of any changes.

Project Description & Location:

The unlawful development in terms of NEMA includes the construction of a residential dwelling which commenced in 2013, on Remainder Portion 9 of Farm Vermaaklikheid No. 499 within 100m of the high-water mark (HWM) of the Duiwenhoks River (estuary), and the installation of a floating dock/jetty on the bank of the Duiwenhoks River on Portion 3 of Farm Kleinefontein No. 503, Vermaaklikheid, in 2021. The residential dwelling was later used for partly rented self-catering tourism accommodation (sleeping <10 people) in 2015.

The development includes the main building (kitchen and lounge), a swimming pool, wooden deck, 3 separate bedrooms and a communal bathroom. Approximately 210m² of the development is located within 100m of the HWM.

The site is located approximately 3km south of Vermaaklikheid, on the eastern bank of the Duiwenhoks River.

Please note that future correspondence will only be sent to registered Interested and Affected Parties. You are also requested to pass this information to any person you feel should be notified.

HESSEQUA MUNICIPALITY PUBLIC NOTICE: AMENDMENT OF THE MUNICIPAL SUPPLY CHAIN MANAGEMENT REGULATIONS AND CLARIFICATION ON IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PREFERENTIAL PROCUREMENT REGULATIONS 2022

On 24 January 2024, Council approved amendments to the Hessequa Municipality Supply Chain Management Policy. Principles and Operational System (SCM Policy). These amendments were necessitated by the amendments National Treasury issued on the Municipal Supply Chain Management Regulations, 2005, effective 14 December 2023 and the clarification from National Treasury on the implementation of the 80/20 Preference Points system as regulated by the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2022.

In summary the amendments and the clarification impact the procurement processes of Hessequa Municipality as follows:

- Goods, services, and works may only be procured by means of petty cash, formal written price quotations and competitive bids.
- Procurement by means of verbal or written price quotations are prohibited.
- The threshold for formal written price quotations have been adjusted from R200,000 (VAT Incl.) to R300,000 (VAT Incl.), which means that formal tenders or competitive bids and long-term contracts should be implemented when the purchase is valued at more than R300,000 (VAT Incl.).
- Requests for formal written price quotations above R30 000 (VAT Incl.) to R300 000 (VAT Incl.) must be advertised for 7 days with all Municipal Bidding Documents as required.
- Requests for formal written price quotations below R30 000 (VAT Incl.) to be advertised for 48 hours as per SCM policy.
- The 80/20 Preferential point system is applicable to the procurement of goods, services and works below R30 000 (VAT Incl.) excluding petty cash purchases.
