**Project Description & Location:** The Swartland Municipality is proposing the establishment of a 132 kV overhead powerline between the De Hoop housing development substation in Malmesbury (currently under construction) and a connection point on the existing Dassenberg/Malmesbury 132 kV overhead powerline located approximately 5 km south of Malmesbury. The connection to existing Dassenberg/Malmesbury powerline will be facilitated by a loop-in/loop-out station. The proposed powerline will transmit the remainder of Portion 15 of the Farm Olympia, Fonth no: 766. The length of the proposed powerline will be approximately 4500 m long with a servitude of 31 m.


