NEMA PUBLIC PARTICIPATION PROCESS

SECTION 24G APPLICATION FOR THE UNLAWFUL CLEARANCE OF VEGETATION AND CONSTRUCTION OF A DAM ON FARM 91, RIVERSDALE

Notice is hereby given of the intention to submit an application, and the public participation, process in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998), as amended ("NEMA"), Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations 2014, for the unlawful clearance of vegetation and construction of a dam on Farm 91, Riversdale, Western Cape. The unlawful activities are in contravention of Section 24F of the NEMA, and includes activities listed in terms of the NEMA EIA Regulations, 2010 and 2014.

EnviroAfrica cc has been appointed by CJ Engelbrecht Familie Trust, to undertake the Section 24G Application for Environmental Authorisation process.

Application for environmental authorization to undertake the following activities*:

<u>Project Description & Location</u>: The unlawful development in terms of NEMA includes the clearance of approximately 7,7ha of indigenous vegetation, over two separate areas, for the establishment and expansion of agricultural lands.

A small farm dam (~900m³) has also been constructed within an area identified as a wetland.

The site is located on Farm 91, Riversdale, approximately 14km north-east of Heidelberg and 20km north-west of Riversdale.

Site co-ordinates (approximate centre-point): Area 1: 33° 58' 52.80" S, 21° 02' 55.90"E.

Area 2: 33° 59' 21.60" S, 21° 03' 13.05"E. Dam: 33° 59' 13.20" S, 21° 03' 25.70"E.

- will be notified of the availability of reports and other written submissions made (or to be made) to the Department by the applicant, and be entitled to comment on these reports and submissions;
- will be notified of the outcome of the application, the reasons for the decision, and that an appeal may be lodged against a decision; and
- will be notified of the applicant's intention to appeal the decision of the competent authority, together with an indication of where and for what period the appeal submission will be available for inspection.


